REPORT: DAY THREE OF EARLY VOTING IN DALLAS COUNTY

It appears that the check-in problems that occurred on the first day of voting have decreased but have not been eliminated. Voters continue to receive ballots that are not correct.

It is essential that the Republican Party gather documentation. Reach out to friends and neighbors. If they have already voted, confirm that they received the correct ballot style. Encourage voters to file complaints if they did not receive the correct ballot. For those who have not voted, notify them of the problems. Advise all voters to know their **precinct numbers**.

An individual's **precinct number** is on the voter's registration certificate (the small card that is mailed to all registered voters). A voter can also go to dallascountyvotes.org to obtain his **precinct number** as well as find his Congressional District and Senatorial District.

To ensure your vote counts:

- Know your **precinct number** before you vote
- Look at the **precinct number** on the top of your ballot
- Look at the Express Vote carefully while voting to ensure your selection appears on the screen.
- Check your ballot before inserting it into the tabulator
