RESOLUTION OF THE DALLAS COUNTY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REGARDING THE 89TH TEXAS STATE LEGISLATIVE SESSION PRIORITIES

WHEREAS, over 8,000 delegates from all 31 Senate Districts across Texas were duly elected and sent to the Republican Party of Texas State Convention on May 23-25, 2024 in San Antonio, Texas;

WHEREAS, a key objective of the RPT State Convention was to determine the Republican Legislative Priorities for the 89th Legislative Session; and

WHEREAS, delegates were presented with a list of 15 topics selected by the Legislative Priorities Committee after a comprehensive review of resolutions passed at the precinct and senate district levels of the convention process; and

WHEREAS, delegates voted to prioritize the following eight topics, which became the official Legislative Priorities of the Republican Party of Texas;

- 1. Border Enforcement
- 2. Secure Texas Elections
- 3. Stop Sexualizing Texas' Kids
- 4. No Democrat Chairs
- 5. Ban Taxpayer-Funded Lobbying
- 6. Secure the Electric Grid
- 7. Texas is Not for Sale
- 8. End Federal Overreach

WHEREAS, Republicans hold the majority in both the Texas House of Representatives and the Texas Senate; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dallas County Executive Committee calls on the 89th Texas State Legislature not to enact legislation and rulemaking with respect to any topic other than any of the important objectives duly voted upon and prioritized by the elected delegates and detailed in these Republican Legislative Priorities, which result in one or more of the priorities not being enacted by the end of the legislative session.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Dallas County Executive Committee considers that any Republican legislator who takes an action in opposition, to hinder or delay these legislative priorities is committing a censurable offense.
