Texas Decertifies Electronic Poll Books After Multitudes of Documented Election Day Failures

(DALLAS, TX) –The Texas Secretary of State has decertified the Elections System & Software (ES&S) electronic pollbooks after repeated notifications of major problems were made by many, including representatives of the Dallas County Republican Party (DCRP) during early voting for the 2024 general election.

In addition, this is not the first time either. Several counties across the state have reported many problems with the ES&S e-pollbooks as early as 2020.

For voters, the risk of illegal and/or illegally certified software makes votes extremely vulnerable from tabulation to ballot scanning errors, just to name a few. During a recent Logic & Accuracy Test, the Central Accumulator, the main tabulation computer that counts votes on election night, made serious tabulation errors for multiple Dallas County races.

DCRP Chairman Allen West has publicly made this issue of concern known on behalf of the party, since initially calling for an independent audit of the Dallas County Elections Department last June.

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“I applaud the decision of the Texas Secretary of State’s office to decertify the ES&S e-pollbooks,” he said. “The Dallas County Republican Party’s valid concerns were evidenced in the November 2024 election which we also publicly addressed.”

Chairman West says now is not the time to replace one failed system with another. “It’s time to solely adopt an in-person signature poll book system which will lead Dallas County to precinct level voting operations and eliminate countywide voting procedures that only enhance voting irregularities.”

He emphasized that now more than ever election fraud issues must be resolved to restore overall confidence in Dallas County and the entire Lone Star State.

“Everyone should be looking at the Dallas County Commissioner’s Court and the Dallas County Elections Department to make these critical decisions to restore fair and honest elections and confidence in the voters.”
