RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT CENSURE OF TEXAS HOUSE REPRESENTATIVES

WHEREAS, the Republicans of Texas expect and deserve elected Republicans who abide by the principles, platform, and priorities of the Republican Party of Texas;

WHEREAS, historically, some candidates have betrayed the Republican voters by running on the Republican platform as Republicans and then working against these values and priorities during their tenure;

WHEREAS, in order to prevent the above issue and encourage candidates supportive of the party values to run for office as Republicans, the Republican Party of Texas through our delegates and our state convention adopted rules which outline a process for Censure of Elected Republicans who commit three censurable acts or more and detail possible penalties including exclusion of the individual from the Republican ballot for two years;

WHEREAS, although Censure must arise from the voters from the districts of the elected officials, the censurable acts of the elected officials affect Republicans from the entire state;

WHEREAS, many Republicans in the Texas House of Representatives have committed multiple acts which are censurable because they are in opposition to one or more of the following:

1. Core Principle No. 5 of the Republican Party of Texas defined in the Platform Preamble as “Personal accountability and responsibility” by violating the Republican Party Caucus Rules, the SREC Resolution passed Dec 6, 2024, Plank 213.a
2. Republican Party of Texas Legislative Priority No. 4 “No Democrat Chairs”
3. Core Principle No.1 Adherence to the US and Texas Constitutions including Article 1, Section 2 of the Texas Constitution which states that all political power comes from the people
4. Texas Health and Safety Code Section 81B.002 which prohibits mandates for face-coverings

WHEREAS, these acts are enumerated below and summarized and quantified in the spreadsheet (see attached):

1. Left Republican Caucus Speaker Vote in attempt to deny quorum (Violating 1)
2. Voted for Rep Dustin Burrows for Speaker and not the Republican Caucus candidate (Violating 1)

3. Seconded Motion to “Call Previous Question” thus squashing debate on House Rules (Violating 3)
4. Voted to Squash all Debate on House Rules (Violating 3)
5. Voted for the House Rules (Violating 2,3)
6. Voted to mandate committee members and the public wear masks by voting for the Rules (Violating 4)
7. Voted to create 30 powerful Democrat Vice-chairs by voting for the Rules (Violating 2)
8. Voted for appointment of 6 Democrats into Chair positions on powerful newly formed Permanent Standing sub-Committees by voting for Rep Burrows as Speaker of the House (Violating 2)

BE IT RESOLVED, the Dallas County Republican Party fully supports any and all Censures arising from fellow Counties/Districts against any of the aforementioned representatives;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Dallas County Republican Party urges the State Republican Executive Committee to vote to concur with the censures and exclude these individuals from the Republican ballot;

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be delivered to the Republican leadership within the Texas House of Representatives, Governor Greg Abbott, Lt. Governor Dan Patrick, Atty. General of Texas Ken Paxton, the Republican Party of Texas (RPT) Chair Abraham George, RPT Vice Chair D'rinda Randall, and be made available to the public for full transparency.
