

## Dallas County Republican Party Chairman Vision

## Mission:

The mission of the Dallas County Republican Party is to elect principled constitutional conservative Republicans in order to maintain and restore individual rights, freedoms, and liberty, strengthen business and property rights, support the rule of law, protect the citizenry, enable educational choice, regain electoral confidence, protect life (our first unalienable right), and stop human and sex trafficking.

## Enabling Tasks:

This is to be accomplished by a conviction to achieve the following enabling tasks.

- Grow our number of dedicated DCRP precinct leadership. Our goal is to increase this number by 50 in the first 100 days. We will strive to have by the end of CY 2024 increased our DCRP precinct leadership by 50%. We will prioritize voting precincts and when possible, establish collateral coverage. The DCRP will not reject the application of anyone seeking to be a precinct leader, who passes the vetting process.

- Develop an 18 month to one year cycle of recruiting candidates for positions in Dallas County. We can no longer afford to send out emails just weeks before the filing deadline asking for people to run for elected office in Dallas County. We will establish a Dallas County elected positions chart and start seeking to put names against those positions early and provide guidance and training.

- In the coming 2024 election cycle, our efforts will be to aid and assist the current Dallas County GOP slate of candidates to find success. When appropriate we will challenge candidates and incumbents to be principled and support the Republican Party of Texas legislative priorities and ballot propositions.

- We will work with organizations like the Leadership Institute to conduct quarterly candidate training sessions. We will also develop a candidate handbook and have local experts provide insights on such aspects as financial compliance, communications, website building.

- We will strongly support restoring election confidence by advocating for the return of precinct level voting, no more countywide voting. Along with that, ensure that we do not have illegal immigrants voting in our elections, end the use of unsolicited mail in ballots, and propose the conducting of monthly 10-15% voter registration roll review. The DCRP supports the return of precinct level paper ballots hand counted at the respective precincts. We also support expanding the options in Chapter 65 of the Texas Elections Code allowing more options for hand counted balloting. As well, we disavow the Texas Secretary of State office granting waivers from election law. Bureaucrats do not have the constitutional power to waive law, that is a legislative branch enumerated duty and responsibility.

- The DCRP will focus not on the empty term "outreach" but instead community engagement. Dallas County is truly a multicultural area, but we all possess fundamental principles and values – our Judeo-Christian faith, strength of families, quality of education, individual responsibility, small business entrepreneurship, safe communities, and national security. We will go forward into all communities across this County metroplex articulating those foundations, as we engage, which is a consistent, resolute, and committed perspective, not just focused on election cycles.

- Stand against human and sex trafficking, one of the sad realities about Dallas County is that we are one of the preeminent areas for sex trafficking. The DCRP will make this a priority target and work with local groups in supporting an end to this scourge by legislative action, and law enforcement. First and foremost, we must seek out the victims and provide them with rescue and then safe harbor.

- Along the same lines, the DCRP will champion the cause of our children to protect them from being sexualized by disturbing perversions and indoctrination. We will be very focal in speaking out against ideological agendas that harm our children and supersede their receiving a quality education. Also, we must protect the most vulnerable amongst us, be the voice for the voiceless, our unborn children. The DCRP will not support the idea of dismembering unborn children on demand as a means of birth control. We believe that the life of the child and mother must be protected, and we will work with local pro-life centers and organizations to provide the viable alternative of choosing life.

I would be remiss if I did not address the issue of fundraising for the DCRP. I am quite sure that there are those who will want to see our failure. Regardless, we will push to have a strong fundraising effort year around. In the initial 100 days our goal will be to raise \$250K. And we will have a fall DCRP event, that will be more casual and available to everyone. We want to boost our \$25-\$100 monthly donors, and there will be full transparency in our financial endeavors and reports. We will seek sponsors for our training programs. The bottom line is that we will give donors a reason to support the DCRP.

- Change in culture, we will restore a winning culture, not one that settles, certainly not one that accepts losing. In the 2020 presidential election, Democrats out voted Republicans by 291,076 votes. We will not make up that number overnight, the last time Republicans out voted Democrats in Dallas County was 2004. However, in this 2024 presidential election cycle, we will work hard to decrease that gap to 200K. That means we must have a better ground game and data to support energizing people to vote against the decimation of our Republic. This also means having a more visible and relevant DCRP that you will see and hear on news media outlets.

- Make the DCRP a professional organization, that means when you walk into our office or attend our County Executive Committee meetings you will witness the utmost standards in professionalism. We will revise our website to be more user friendly. Make our headquarters a functional operations center. And the CEC meetings will be run by Roberts Rules of Order with a professional parliamentarian on hand...and the Chairman conducts the meeting where the will of the body is respected and regarded.

In closing, Rome was indeed not built in a day, and the most important part of any journey is the first step. The Greek philosopher Plato once quipped, "one of the penalties for refusing to participate in politics is that you shall be governed by your inferiors". I am asking constitutional conservatives to participate, this is about the one true legacy that you can, or cannot, leave to your subsequent generations...Freedom, Liberty.

Our first General and President, George Washington one said, "We are either a united people or we are not. If the former, let us, in all matters of general concern act as a nation, which has national objects to promote, and a national character to support. If we are not, let us no longer act a farce by pretending to it".

Texas ain't no place for amateurs and those who would undermine our national character and our national sovereignty, so let's stop electing them.
