Ally Raskin made a motion to appoint new precinct chairs. Motion was second and passed.

Chairman Remarks:

The voter turnout goal for the Municipal Election was 20%. We fell woefully short at 6-7%. PCs were encouraged to get out the vote for the municipal runoff.

A Resolution to censure Representative Morgan Myers and Representative Angie Chin Button will be considered at the June 16 CEC meeting. The two representatives have been invited to attend the meeting.

Treasurer's Report: Balance of \$184,798 (Report attached). Reagan Day Dinner earned \$33157.00

Dee Holley, DCRP Executive Director, recognized volunteers who participated in the Municipal Elections: Mike Hook, Brittne Trout, David Garcia, Jeff Vogt. She announced a fund raiser for Everett Jackson. DCRP will participate in a Memorial Day ceremony by placing 6000 roses on gravesites at DFW National Cemetery on the morning of May 26.

Committee Reports:

Election Oversight: Susan Cumby announced that DCRP must submit to the Election Department a list of names for Early Voting Alternate Judges, Election Day Judges &

Alternate Judges, Ballot Board, and Central Count. These individuals will be approved by the Commissioner's Court to serve the 2026-2028 term. Poll Watchers are needed for the Municipal Runoff.

Candidate Recruitment: Ajua Mason encouraged PCs to show support for Municipal candidates. PCs should contact Joe Washburn (jwashburn@pm.me) or Ajua Mason (972.339.0214) for a list of voters in their precincts. Sign Up Genius will be available for those wanting to volunteer to poll watch. PCs can access Project Broadcast (\$100) for texting. Candidate recruitment was discussed. It was suggested that Those considering running for office should explore serving on city and county boards and seek out advice from previous candidates or elected officials.

New Business:

Bruce Bishop made a motion to reinstate Tillie Perkins as Precinct Chair for PC 3310. Motion was second. PCs are notified by certified mail when one has missed four consecutive meetings and a response is requested. It was determined that Tillie Perkins and Ally Raskin would communicate with each other. Bruce Bishop made a motion to withdraw his previous motion and proposed that Ally Raskin work with Tillie Perkins to resolve the issue. Motion was second and passed.
