Chairman Remarks:

It is important that Republicans do not engage in fighting with each other. Precinct Chairs must work to turn out a 40% Republican vote in the March Primary. PC's need to know the candidates running in the primary and support the candidates. Candidate meet & greets are posted on Dallasgop.org. Senatorial District Conventions will be held on Saturday, March 28. Redistricting does not effect current Precinct Chairs and Precinct Conventions. Redistricted Precinct Chairs will be sworn in twenty (20) days after the Primary Election runoff.

It is important to support municipal candidates. The filing deadline for municipal elections is mid February

The Election Oversight Committee met January 13 at headquarters to develop a proactive plan for the Primary Election.

The Dallas County Election Department will notify voters of their precinct voting locations:

1. TV advertising, social media; dallascountyvotes.org;
2. Direction signage and QR code posted at “regular” voting locations.
3. Guides at high turnout locations that are not being used.

DCRP will post voting locations on GOP website with an interactive map.

Precinct chairs should assist at voting locations to publicize Precinct Conventions

Republicans will serve as Presiding Election Officers for Early Voting and will serve as

Judges on Election Day. There are 74 Early Voting Locations and approximately 245 Election Day locations.

New Business:

Ken Hollingsworth made a motion to hold Precinct Conventions on March 5 (two days after the election). The motion was second. Floor was opened for discussion with three speaking in favor and three speaking against the motion. Walt Nickels called the question and the motion passed by a standing vote.
