

DIRECTIVE FOR COMPLIANCE AND AUTHORIZATION OF ENFORCEMENT

WHEREAS, the County Executive Committee (“CEC”) is the governing authority of the Dallas County Republican Party (DCRP) and retains supervisory authority over primary election administration decisions pursuant to Texas Election Code §172.111(b); and

WHEREAS, the December 31, 2025 Contract requiring precinct-based voting remains in full force and effect;

WHEREAS, failure to comply with the governing contract constitutes actionable noncompliance and exposes the DCRP to legal risk;

WHEREAS, clarity and uniform compliance are necessary to avoid voter confusion and preserve orderly election administration; and therefore

BE IT RESOLVED,

- All DCRP officials shall comply strictly and without deviation with the December 31, 2025 Contract;
- The acting Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, Executive Director, and other Party leadership including Resolutions and Election Oversight Committee Chairs shall immediately (by 12 pm noon April 21, 2026) provide written notice to the Dallas County Elections Department, the Texas Secretary of State, the Texas Attorney General and all relevant parties confirming the controlling agreement;
- In the event of noncompliance by 12 pm noon, April 21, 2026
 - The CEC authorizes Precinct Chair (#2016) and the Resolutions Committee Chair, Barry Wernick, to have full authority on behalf of the CEC to notify immediately by written notice to the Dallas County Elections Department, the Texas Secretary of State, the Texas Attorney General, and all relevant parties confirming Chairman Allen B. West had no authority to sign the First Amendment and that the controlling agreement is the December 31, 2025 Contract;
- The CEC authorizes Barry Wernick to have full authority to organize enforcement to implement this resolution without further vote.
