Resolutions Committee Report: Barry Wernick introduced Resolution: Directive for Compliance and Authorization of Enforcement. Floor was opened for discussion with four (4) Precinct Chairs speaking in favor of the resolution and four (4) speaking in opposition to the resolution. A motion was made to vote by secret ballot. Motion was second and failed to pass. Lee Baldwin made a motion to move to executive session. It was second and passed. The number of Precinct Chairs present was confirmed to be 135. Lee Baldwin made a motion for a standing vote and it was second and passed with 93 voting in favor and 35 against. Motion passed. Resolution: Directive for Compliance and Authorization of Enforcement passed with 128 in favor and 35 opposed.

Barry Wernick introduced second resolution: Reaffirmation of Contract and Rejection of Unauthorized Amendment. Corrine Smith made a motion to close debate. Motion was second and passed. Robert Higgins submitted an amendment to the resolution Directive for Compliance and Authorization of Enforcement. Amendment was ruled out

of order. Mr. Higgins requested that his proposed amendment be recorded with the minutes. James Moyers motioned for a division of the house which was second and passed. Motion passed with 102 voting in favor and 24 against.

Election Oversight Committee Report: Lee Jenkins made a request for Precinct Chairs to work the upcoming elections.

Wes Bowen made a motion to adjourn. It was second and passed.
